Weather Forecast and Flood, Rainfall and River Situation

Current Situation: The low over South West Bay and adjoining South East Bay moves Northwestwards and intensified. Weather is likely to remain mainly dry with tempo. partly cloudy sky over the country. Dry spell prevails over the country. No flood situation prevails over the country.

WEATHER FORECAST (VALID FOR 24 HOURS COMMENCING 09 AM TODAY)

Synoptic Situation: The low over Southwest Bay and adjoining Southeast Bay moved Northwestwards intensified into a depression and now lies over West central Bay and adjoining Southwest Bay. It is likely to intensify further and move in a west-northwesterly direction. Its associated trough extends to North Bay.

Forecast: Weather is likely to remain mainly dry with tempo. partly cloudy sky over the country.

Day temperature may remain nearly unchanged over the country.

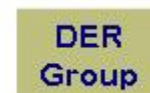

FLOOD, RAINFALL AND RIVER SITUATION SUMMARY (October 29, 2007)

Outlook

- Dry spell prevails over the country.
- All the rivers are flowing well below their respective danger levels.
- No flood situation prevails over the country.

Rainfall

- Almost nil rainfall recorded during last 24hrs ending at 6AM today.

General River Condition

- Water Level stations: **Above danger level***: 0 Rise: 0 Fall: 45 steady: 1 No data: 17
- All the rivers in the Brahmaputra, the Ganges, the Meghna & South- Eastern Hill basins observed fall.
- All the rivers are flowing below their respective danger levels.

** Danger level at a river location is the level above which it is likely that the flood may cause damages to nearby crops and homesteads. In a river having no embankment, danger level is about annual average flood level. In an embanked river, danger level is fixed slightly below design flood level of the embankment.*
