Special Weather Bulletin; Weather Forecast and Flood, Rainfall and River Situation

Current Situation: The well marked low weakened into a low pressure. Maritime ports of Chittagong, Cox's Bazar and Mongla have been advised to lower signal. Rain/ T. showers accompanied by tempo. Gusty/squally wind is likely to occur at several places over the country. Dry spell prevails over the country. All the rivers are flowing well below their respective danger levels.

SPECIAL WEATHER BULLETIN (Date: October 31, 2007 at 1830 BST)

THE WELL MARKED LOW OVER WEST CENTRAL BAY AND ADJOINING SOUTH WEST BAY OF ANDHRA - TAMILNADU COAST WEAKENED INTO A LOW PRESSURE AREA OVER THE SAME AREA AT 06 PM TODAY (31 OCTOBER, 2007).

MARITIME PORTS OF CHITTAGONG, COX'S BAZAR AND MONGLA HAVE BEEN ADVISED TO LOWER DISTANT CAUTIONARY SIGNAL NUMBER ONE (R) ONE.

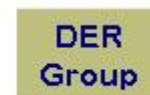

WEATHER FORECAST (VALID FOR 24 HOURS COMMENCING 09 AM TODAY)

Synoptic Situation: The well marked low over west central bay and adjoining south west bay of Andhra - Tamilnadu coast weakened into a low pressure area over the same area. Its associated troughs extend to north-west bay.

The Disaster Management Information Centre is the information hub of the Ministry of Food and Disaster Management for risk reduction, hazard early warnings and emergency response and recovery activities



Forecast: Rain/ T. showers accompanied by tempo. gusty/squally wind is likely to occur at one or two places over Dhaka, Khulna, Barisal, Chittagong, Rajshahi and Sylhet divisions.

Night temperature may remain nearly unchanged over the country.

FLOOD, RAINFALL AND RIVER SITUATION SUMMARY (November 01, 2007)

Outlook

- Dry spell prevails over the country.
- All the rivers are flowing well below their respective danger levels.
- No flood situation prevails over the country.

RAINFALL

- Significant rainfalls recorded during last 24hrs ending at 6AM today are:
- Satkhira: 19.5 mm, Faridpur: 17.0 mm, Jessore: 12.0 mm.

General River Condition

- Water Level stations: **Above danger level*:** 0 Rise: 1 Fall: 35 steady: 4
- All the rivers in the Brahmaputra, the Ganges, the Meghna & South- Eastern Hill basins observed fall.
- All the rivers are flowing below their respective danger levels.

** Danger level at a river location is the level above which it is likely that the flood may cause damages to nearby crops and homesteads. In a river having no embankment, danger level is about annual average flood level. In an embanked river, danger level is fixed slightly below design flood level of the embankment.*
